GRADUATION RATE

As reported in the CAPTE Annual Accreditation Report each December. Graduation rate is defined by the [Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education \(CAPTE\)](#) as the completion of the program within 150 percent of the length of the program and does not include those students that left the program for reasons other than academic deficit.
