**The A.O.S. in Ultrasound Technology Program** includes academic, laboratory training, and a clinical component correlating with theoretical knowledge.

**Students use Simtics online simulators** to strengthen scanning protocols and pathology recognition skills.

**Our Ultrasound Scan Laboratory is equipped** with multiple ultrasound machines and an Ankle-Brachial Index (ABI) machine, allowing students to practice scanning one another.

**All students will receive four (4) clinical rotations** in various settings, including imaging centers and hospitals. The students have the opportunity to develop and strengthen their general and OB-GYN skills during externships.
