The A.O.S. in Vascular Ultrasound Technology Program includes academic, laboratory training, and a clinical component correlating with theoretical knowledge.

Students use Simtics online simulators to strengthen scanning protocols and pathology recognition skills.

Our Ultrasound Scan Laboratory is equipped with multiple ultrasound machines and an Ankle-Brachial Index (ABI) machine, allowing students to practice scanning one another.

All students will receive two (2) clinical rotations in various settings, including imaging centers and hospitals. The students have the opportunity to develop and strengthen vascular skills during externships.
