## IV THERAPY AND BLOOD WITHDRAWAL CERTIFICATION COURSE



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### Program Highlights

**36-hour course includes didactic sessions and a clinical practicum**

- The course spans two consecutive weekends.
- Three nine-hour days of didactic training focused on the theory and principles of intravenous therapy and blood withdrawal.
- Participants will complete a nine-hour clinical practicum in a clinical skills lab setting.
- Students will perform at least three individually supervised successful venipunctures.
- Students will perform three skin punctures (capillary blood withdrawals) on live human subjects.
- BVNPT-approved program.
- Focus on mastering intravenous therapy and blood withdrawal procedures with utmost safety and effectiveness.
