	To request that aid be reviewed due to these or similar circumstances, the student must write a letter explaining in detail the reason for the request and complete a form. Appropriate documentation will be required and will be suitable for the circumstance. For			
	example, if a student is claiming to be Unemployed, he/she may be required to produce a current pay statement, w-2 and/or tax return. Students will be notified of what reasonable documentation they will need to produce after the written appeal has been reviewed. The student must be enrolled at the time the request for professional judgment is made. Requests must be received by the Financial Aid Office two weeks prior to the last day of classes. All decisions are made on a case-by-case basis after reviewing the student's individual circumstances. The student should be aware that while the institution attempts to make a final decision promptly, there may be instances where additional information is required which may delay the decision. The decision of the Financial Aid Office at Gurnick is final and cannot be appealed to the US Department of Education.
