The Medical Assistant Program consists of lectures that illuminate human anatomy and introduce students to the world of Medical Terminology.

Lab hours will be spent practicing hands-on patient care. Students will learn to take vitals and EKGs, use a Holter monitor, perform specimen collection, sterilize instruments, and more.

Program curriculum delivers training for front office management, patient privacy, treatment records for continuity of care and accurate billing, and management of Electronic Health Records (EHR).

Students prepare for the Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA) and Certified EKG Technician (CET) exams. Gurnick Academy is an NHA-approved proctoring site, allowing students to test oncampus. Gurnick Academy pays for exam fees. Students who pass will receive their respective certficates.
